



Pathophysiology

Prerequisites: Completion of coursework in Medical Terminology and Anatomy are recommended.

Clock Hours: 18 hours

Approved CEUs: Approved for CEUs upon successful completion towards CPC, CPC-P, CPB, CPMA, CPPM, and Specialty Credentials except CIRCC (one-time use only).

Course Length: To be completed at student's own pace within a 12-month period or less. Enrollment date begins at date of purchase.
