


IMPORTANT TERMS

Hallux Valgus: A condition where the big toe deviates outward towards the other toes, causing a bony prominence on the inner side of the foot.


Bunion: A bony bump that forms at the base of the big toe joint, often associated with hallux valgus.

Bunionectomy: Surgical removal or correction of a bunion.

Osteotomy: A surgical procedure in which a bone is cut and realigned to correct deformity or alter its length or alignment.








Correction, hallux valgus with bunionectomy, with sesamoidectomy, when performed; with resection of proximal phalanx base, when performed, any method



Correction, hallux valgus with bunionectomy, with sesamoidectomy, when performed; with PROXIMAL metatarsal osteotomy; any method






Proximal Phalanx Medial eminence of metatarsal bone osteotomy First Metatarsal


Correction, hallux valgus with bunionectomy, with sesamoidectomy, when performed; with DISTAL metatarsal osteotomy; any method
